Detailed notification for Web Based Counseling

The qualified and eligible candidates of TG Ed.CET-2026 Examination are informed to attend web-based counselling for admission into two years B.Ed. course for the academic years 2026-2027, as per G.O.Ms. No. 92 Edn. (SE) dt 16-11-2006, G.O.Ms. No.24, dated: 24/08/2017 and its amendments G.O. Ms. No. 14 dt 12-04-2021, G.O. Ms. No.16 dt 11-06-2021, and G.O. Ms. No. 33 dt 30-09-2022, as per the schedule given.

-  Candidates are informed that they should satisfy the admission rules prescribed in the related G.O.Ms. No. 92 Edn. (SE) dt 16-11-2006, G.O.Ms. No.24, dated: 24-08-2017 and its amendments G.O. Ms. No. 14 dt 12-04-2021 and G.O. Ms. No. 16 dt 11-06-2021 and should be prepared to pay the tuition fee as applicable.
-  This notification itself is a call for web counselling. No separate call letters are sent to the individual candidates.
-  Mere attending of the web counselling does not guarantee a seat.
-  All candidates are informed to register online at <https://edcetadm.tgche.ac.in> from **21st July to 28th July, 2026** and furnish the required information in the application form. **All the entries should be correct and the candidate is solely responsible for any incorrect entry.**
-  All the candidates must pay non-refundable processing Fee Rs. 800.00 (Rupees: Eight Hundred only) and Rs. 500.00 (Rupees: Five Hundred only) in case of SC/ST Candidates towards **Registration cum Verification** process which has to be paid through online payment Credit Cards/Debit Cards/Internet Banking in favour of ‘**Secretary, TGCHE**’.

- ✚ Special categories i.e., PWD/CAP/NCC/Sports (SG) certificates shall be verified during First Phase of counselling only on scheduled date and time. No further Certificate Verification for Special Categories after schedule date. No Certificate Verification for Special Categories in Second Phase.
- ✚ Allotments for NCC/Sports categories will be made in subsequent phases only after due verification from the concerned authorities.
- ✚ Tuition fee particulars and seats available under Convener Quota College wise will be notified on the websites: <https://edcetadm.tgche.ac.in> well before the commencement of counselling (option entry). Tuition Fee and Special Fee as fixed by the Government shall be paid per annum.
- ✚ In respect of reimbursement of Tuition Fee will be as per guidelines issued vide G.O.Ms.No. 08 and 09 dated 06-06-2026 Scheduled Castes Development (EDN.A1) Department and further guidelines issued by Government from time to time.
- ✚ The Candidate once allotted seat shall note that if they exercise options in Second/Final phase and a seat is allotted as per the options, the vacated seat will be allotted to next meritorious candidate and hence they will have no claim on previous allotment.
- ✚ Physical reporting of the candidate at the allotted college is mandatory in every phase.
- ✚ It is mandatory to exercise options afresh for Each phase. First phase options will not be considered for Second phase.

b. Eligibility:

1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
2. The candidate should belong to Telangana.
3. The candidates should satisfy the local / unreserved status requirements as specified in G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2026.
4. Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for the **local candidates of O.U. Area** as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and **the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved seats, as follows:**
 - a. All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of O.U. Area.
 - b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;
 - c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
 - d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

5. Eligibility to different methodologies is followed as per G.O.MS No.24, dated: 24-08-2017, G.O. Ms. No. 05 dt 31.01.2020, G.O. Ms. No. 14 dt 12-04-2021 and G.O. Ms. No. 16 dt 11-06-2021.
6. Candidate should have passed or appeared:
 - a) In any Bachelors Degree i.e. B.A, B.Com, B.Sc, B.Sc (Home Science), BCA, BBM, B.A (Oriental Languages), BBA or in the Masters Degree, securing at least 50% aggregate marks.
 - b) Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with 50% aggregate marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto.
 - c) However, candidates belonging to the reserved categories viz., SC/ST/BC and other reserved categories should have secured 40% marks in the qualifying examination.
 - d) Candidates should be required to produce marks memo and pass certificate at the time of Counseling for Admission
 - e) Candidates possessing MBBS/ BSC (AG)/BSC (Horticulture)/BSC (Architecture)/BVSC/BHMT/ B.Pharm and such other professional and job-oriented degree courses viz., LL.B are not eligible for admission into B.Ed course.
 - f) Candidates possessing a Master Degree without having undertaken Undergraduate study are **not eligible** for admission

7. Age Limit:

The candidates should have completed the age of 19 years on 1 st July of the year in which notification is issued. There shall be no maximum age limit.

c. Helpline Centres for Special Category (CAP/NCC/PH/Sports):

The candidates claiming special category are required to book the slot for certificate verification to avoid gathering of many candidates at the same time. However, they have to upload scanned copies of all the relevant original certificates before coming for physical special category certificate verification.

d. Certificates to be uploaded at the time of Registration and filling application form

1. TG Ed.CET-2026 Rank Card
2. Original Degree / Provisional Certificate (PC) & Consolidate Memorandum Marks (CMM) qualifying examination.
3. Intermediate/Diploma / 10+2 Certificate or its equivalent
4. SSC pass certificate or its Equivalent for proof of Date of Birth.
5. Bonafide (Study) certificates from Class IX to Graduation.
6. Residence certificate for preceding 7 years of the qualifying examination i.e. Graduation in respect of candidates who have private study without any institutionalized education (Distance / Open education mode).
7. Residence certificate of either of parents in Telangana for 10 years in case of non-local candidates excluding the period of employment outside the state. This certificate should be obtained from the Tahsildar.

8. In respect of non-local candidates in order to consider them for allotment under unreserved seats the following certificates needs to be submitted.
 - a. **Residence Certificate:** Candidates who has resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State; or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of employment outside the State.
(OR)
 - b. **Employer Certificate:** Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi Public Institutions within the State at the time of applying for TG Ed.CET- 2026) examination
(OR)
 - c. Candidate who are spouses of those in the employment in Telangana or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Govt. or University or Other Competent authority and similar Quasi Govt. Institutions within Telangana at the time of applying for TG Ed.CET- 2026) examination.
9. Transfer Certificate.
10. Latest Integrated community certificate issued by the competent authority in case of BC/SC/ST candidates (issued after 02.06.2014), if applicable.
11. Economically Weaker Sections Candidates should produce EWS Certificate issued by MRO/ Tahsildar valid for the year 2026-27, if applicable. EWS Reservation applicable only to OC candidates,
12. Special category certificates NCC / CAP / PH / SPORTS
13. Latest Parental Income certificate issued by M.R.O. by Govt. of Telangana on or after 01.01.2026, if applicable.
14. The Muslim and Christian Minority Candidates should upload the SSC "TC" containing Minority status (or) in the absence of TC, a Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution in which the student studied/appeared for SSC or its equivalent examination.
15. Aadhar Card or any other valid I.D. proof.

*Note: * Any false or incorrect information furnished detected at any stage will render the admission of the candidate null and void.*

** The Convener reserves the right to cancel the admission of the candidates at any stage if / when it is detected that admission is against the rules*

e. SPECIAL CATEGORY: Certificates to be produced by PH / CAP / NCC / Sports (SG): All original certificates to be scanned and uploaded.

Certificates to be produced by PH / CAP / NCC / Sports (SG) categories: The following original certificates whichever is applicable are to be scanned and uploaded.

1. PH-Certificate issued by District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above disability are only eligible.
2. CAP (Children of Armed Forces Personnel): Candidates whose parents are domiciled in Telangana based on the permanent address/home town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register are alone eligible to be considered under "CAP" Category.
 - a. Children of Armed Forces (CAP) 2% (two percent) for the children of armed persons i.e., Ex-Servicemen, Defence Personnel including the Children of Border Security Force and Central Reserve Police Force who are Domiciled in Telangana based on the Permanent address/ Home town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register.

- b. The Ex-Servicemen have to produce the Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by respective Regional Sainik Welfare Officer as per Appendix-"A" Attached with supporting documents to establish the Permanent address/ Home town declared by Ex-Servicemen while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register in accordance with GO, such as Certificate from Records Office, Education Certificates of Ex-Servicemen, etc.
 - c. Serving Defense Personnel including CRPF and BSF Personnel should submit a Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by unit Commanding officer (not less than the rank of a Colonel/ equivalent in Navy and Air Force Commandant in CRPF/BSF) as per Appendix- "B" Attached along with original and attested copy of Service Register where the Permanent address/ Home town declared by them while joining the service is mentioned along with the education certificates of the Serving Defence personnel.
 - d. The retired CRPF and BSF Personnel have to produce the Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP) certificate issued by their respective competent authority as per Appendix-A along with supporting documents to establish the Permanent address/ Home town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register in accordance with GO, such as Certificate from Records Office, Education Certificates of CRPF/BSF personnel, etc.
3. NCC - Certificates issued by competent authorities.
4. Sports (SG) – Sports Achievements / Testimonials along with the Form- I, II, III & IV (formats provided in the website) duly certified / attested by the Concerned State Sports Associations recognized by the SATS which are categorized according to level of the Championships as laid down in G.O. Ms. No. 02, Youth Advancement, Tourism & Culture (Sports) Department, dated: 22-09-2020, which are essential during Scrutiny.
- i. Candidate must submit **Form I, II, III, or IV** depending on the level of their championship. These forms must be duly certified or attested by the SATS-recognized State Sports Association.
 - ii. Performance is evaluated based only on the best achievements from the last 5 years.**
 - iii. Any tournament or match played after passing your qualifying exam will not be considered.
 - iv. Candidates claiming points for a higher-level achievement, they must also provide the lower-level certificates that led to that competition to prove the chain of performance.

Note: The candidate seeking admission under special categories (NCC / CAP / PH / Sports) have to appear in person (physically present) for verification before the relevant competent authority and are required to bring the following certificates for the support of verification along with relevant special category original certificate. And two sets of photocopies.

- (i) Degree/Provisional Certificate & Consolidate Memorandum of Marks (CMM) of qualifying Examination.
- (ii) 10+2 / Intermediate/Diploma Certificate and memorandum of marks.

(iii) SSC Pass Memo or its Equivalent for proof of Date of Birth.

f. Certificate verification and counselling:

1. The preliminary certificate verification will be done based on scanned copies of original documents uploaded and as per norms.
2. In case of any doubt, enquiry will be done over phone to establish the veracity and correctness of documents.
3. Procedure for exercising options will be made available on the website i.e. <https://edcetadm.tgche.ac.in> well before the commencement of the option entry.
4. List of Provisionally selected candidates will be prepared College wise and will be placed in the website i.e. <https://edcetadm.tgche.ac.in> and SMS will be sent to the valid mobile number furnished in the application.
5. Tuition fee has to be paid through online payment via Credit Cards/Debit Cards/Internet Banking.
6. Final allotment of seat for admission is subject to satisfactory verification of all original certificates at reported college and producing tuition fee receipt.
7. Candidates have to report to the concerned college and produce all original certificates within the stipulated time.
8. Allotment order and joining report will be issued at the allotted college, which has to be submitted at the college along with the original T.C.
9. Candidates have to submit two sets of attested copies of all certificates at the respective colleges, one set is meant for submission to the office of the Convener.
10. If the candidate cancels his/her admission, tuition fee will be forfeited as mentioned below:
 - a. After first phase, full tuition fee will be refunded.
 - b. 50% of the amount after final phase and before cut-off date notified for cancellation in allotment order and 100% thereafter.

g. Rules of Reservation for admission.

Admissions will be made as per rules of reservations in vogue at the time of Counselling.

1. The candidates should satisfy the local / unreserved status requirements as specified in G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2026
2. Admission to 85% of the convener quota seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for **the local candidates of O.U. Area** as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and **the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved seats, as follows:**
 - a. All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of O.U. Area.
 - b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;
 - c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public Institution within the State; and
 - d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

3. Cent-percent (100%) of seats in University College and 75% of the sanctioned intake of seats in unaided (affiliated), non-minority and minority professional institutions will be filled by the Convener TG Ed.CET-2026 Admissions.

 - a. Categories (as per G.O.RI.No.:550 dated 30.07.2001, G.O.Ms.No.33 dated 08-02-2021 and G.O.Ms.No 10 Scheduled Castes Development (POA.A2) Department dated 14-04-2025)
